

Adverse Weather Policy

The Johnson Creek Public Library recognizes that on occasion, inclement weather or other conditions may prevent the library from opening, postpone opening, or require early closing. The primary factor of any decision made will be the safety of staff and library customers. However, maximum effort will be made to maintain regular library operating hours.

In the event that conditions arise requiring an early closing, or delayed opening of the Johnson Creek Public Library due to inclement weather, the Library Director will make the decision to close. In the event that conditions arise, which will not allow the Johnson Creek Public Library to open, the Library Director, following discussion with the Library Board President, will keep the library closed to the public. The decision will take into account the actions of the Johnson Creek School District and safety concerns.

This policy is to help ensure the safety of our customers and staff, and allows for snow removal and the clearing of roads.
